### Award Categories

**Outstanding Kentucky OST Legislative Award:** Community members have made important contributions to advance the field of out-of-school time through legislative or governmental channels. These may be related to support of the Kentucky Out-of-School Alliance as an entity or to the OST field in general. This award recognizes individuals whose work has improved the quality, accessibility, affordability or availability of out-of-school time in Kentucky.

**Outstanding Kentucky OST Leadership Award:** The vision and leadership of outstanding professionals are critical to the advancement of the out-of-school time field. Those individuals who strive to provide the highest quality programs for their communities and at the same time share their special talents to further the out-of-school time field deserve recognition by their peers. This award honors program directors or administrators who have demonstrated special talents, contributions and vision that further the field of out-of-school time.

**Outstanding Kentucky OST Staff Award:** High quality, committed staff members are the key to program excellence and deserve recognition by their peers. This award recognizes individuals who work in the direct day-to-day supervision of children or youth who exemplify excellence in program implementation and commitment to the out-of-school time field.

**Outstanding Kentucky OST Community Partner Award:** Whether functioning in schools, recreation centers, churches, or other environments, it is important to build strong collaborative partnerships with community agencies, organizations, and businesses. This award recognizes the outstanding community partner commitment to the development of children and youth in the out-of-school arena.

**Outstanding Kentucky OST Parent Award:** Parents are an indispensable partner in the success of out-of-school time programs. Their volunteer participation validates the importance of academic success and provides children with a wide variety learning opportunities through a diversity of perspectives. This award is presented to the parent or adult caregiver who has demonstrated the most outstanding volunteer involvement in an out-of-school time program.

**Outstanding Kentucky OST Policymaker Award:** Elected officials represent the interests of their constituency at local, state, and national levels. This award will honor those individuals who have supported working families through their support of quality out-of-school time programs that inspire student learning.
